Attendances at the Clubroom are still very good with between 20 and 30 members there every Tuesday, so all in all, it looks as though the Club will have another good year...

Brian Braybrooke (1948 – 2013) (Dick Lyon)



Brian died in February on the day he had arranged for the funeral of his mother. He was a member of the Icknield Road Club for 20 years until he resigned in 1988 over club sponsorship.

Whilst with the club, Brian was very active taking part in all aspects of club life. His favourite riding was on his tricycle and set several club records. He also toured extensively on both bike and trike here in the UK and also abroad – notably Sweden. Through his life he covered literally hundreds of thousands of miles.

The extent of his riding was reflected by the attendance at his funeral. Apart for The Icknield, there were representatives from Luton Wheelers, Beds Road CC, the Forty Plus CC, the Tricycle Association as well as the Beds, Herts, Cambs, Northampton and South Bucks District Associations of the CTC.

What impressed me most about Brian was his cheerfulness and enthusiasm for everything he did. All this was achieved despite

the fact he was a severe diabetic. He suffered most of the problems that accompany the condition but it never seemed to depress him unduly.

I shall miss seeing Brian out and about on his trike or bike at odd times and going in odd directions. I hope the wind always follows and the tyres stay inflated...

Unfortunately Brian also died in February. He was primarily a rider with the local CTC but was with the club thorough 1961 to 1962.

With the Icknield he competed quite usefully in road racing, but marriage and family commitments meant that cycling took a lower priority.



Important Notes:

- 1. If you are unable to turn up for ANY REASON you should in the instance endeavour to swap with someone to take your place.
- 2. If you are unable to find a substitute, then please contact organiser Steve Chapman 01582 534454 or 07743 170663. If signs or marshals are missing then the event may have to be cancelled as not conforming to Risk Assessment.
- 3. The A507 events (9 off), Peter Jones will sign these.
- 4. Marshall (C) = Clophill RAB (A507 & A6).
- Marshall (M) = Maulden RAB (A507).
- 6. Both the Pusher-off and Marshal for Higher Berry circuit should leave HQ at least 15 minutes before Start time of 1st rider, to allow sufficient time to put Signs out.
- 7. The Marshall at Higher Berry should take 3 signs from clubroom. Two to be placed at junction of Woburn Road to Eversholt, the other at the marshalling point, junction with Woburn Rd to the west of the junction.
- 8. The Higher Berry circuit Pusher -off should take 4 signs from the Clubroom. One to be placed at the T junction, about 1 mile after the Start. The other 3 to be at the Start X-rds, to the **South, East** and **North** of the X-rds.
