Icknield youngsters Go-Ride at Shefford (Ray Morgan)

With no Cyclo-Cross League event on the weekend of 10/11th November six Icknield Road Club under 16s went to Shefford for Go-Ride Racing.

In the Cyclo-Cross time trial Enasio Rosselli Sharpe did 1m 23s, Silus McQueen 1m 24s, Uzeir Zulfqur 1m 27s, Sufiyan Hussain 1m 31s, Steven Russell 1m 33s and George Litchfield 1m 48s.

Sufiyan Hussain made 3rd in the under 10s race. Racing for 14 minutes Silus McQueen was the 4th under 12. In the combined U14/U16s race, Steven Russell was 3rd, Uzeir Zulfqur 6th, Enasio Rosselli Sharpe 7th and George Litchfield finished 12th after 17 minutes.

Go-Ride Racing is for under 16 year old novice riders only and is to encourage them to start racing and progress to higher levels.

U10s Nathan Hardy 3:03mins, Sufiyan Hussain 3:26mins, Ishaq Faruk 3:50mins, Sean O'Brien 3:51mins, Leeya Hussain 3:53mins, Habeel Bensharif 4:11mins, Hafsa Faruk 5:27mins.

A certificate was presented to the first three in each category.

In the three lap combined U12/U14s Cyclo-Cross race medal winners were; Gold, Nathan Huggins/Steven Russell, Silver, Kacey Findley/Enasio Rosselli, Bronze, Usman Faruk/Silus McQueen.

Racing for 10 minutes over two laps the U10 Gold medal winner was Nathan Hardy, Silver, Sufiyan Hussain and Bronze, Leeya Hussain.

A very exciting Team Relay Race was won by Enasio Rosselli, Sufiyan Hussain and Sean O'Brian, second were Ishaq Faruk, Nathan Huggins and Steven Russell, third place was taken by Silus McQueen, Kacey Findley and Leeya Hussain. All 14 competitors got to keep a Go-Ride Games T-Shirt with prizes for the first 12.

This very successful event organised by the Icknield Road Club and supported by British Cycling left the young riders asking for more racing.

There were some stunning rides from Icknield RC members in the fifth round of the British Cycling Central League Cyclo-Cross series on Saturday 27th October.

In the superb setting of Magdalen College School, Brackley, the 13th century school chapel is the oldest still in use in England, on a bitterly cold day the A5 Rangers hosted a super event with 12 lcknielders' competing.

Dennis Lysbygd won the combined senior / women / junior race by a big margin starting from the second row on the grid. Lauren Randall came second in the junior female section and is top of her league, having ridden all the rounds so far. New member Oliver Cocks was the fourth junior after racing for over an hour.

The youth race for under 16s lasted 30 minutes and Peter Lewis came home 11th, Steven Russell 18th, Enasio Rosselli (age 11) 22nd, Uzair Zulfgar 23rd and Helen Simpkins 28th.

In the under 12s Nathan Huggins finished 12th and is 18th in the league. The Icknield RC had three riders in the under 10s with Leeya Hussain on the podium as third girl. Sufiyan Hussain and James Payne-Fraser placed 13th and 14th respectively.

Gone but not forgotten ...

Maurice Cray (1931-2012) by John Lee

It is with sadness we report the passing of Maurice Cray, Life Member and former president of the Club.

Maurice joined the club in 1949 at the end of 18 when the Icknield was the racing offshoot of the Beds D.A. of the CTC. After a year of touring with members he took up racing and soon showed his prowess at short distance time trials, winning the Club 30 Mile Championship in 1952 and the Club 25 mile Championship in 1953 and 1954.

Maurice was team leader with Ron Burnet and Dave Young winning several open team events and in 1955 he rode with Ron Burnet and Bill Dixon (who has been our sponsor for many years) winning the Kettering Amateur 25 Mile Team award. Maurice's one ambition was to beat the hour at 25, doing many 0s and 1s — he finally achieved his goal with a 59 ride in 1955 and in 1956 he was Club Hill Climb Champion climbing Sundon Hill in 2 minutes and 2 seconds.

On the admin side Maurice was General Secretary and Treasurer from 1951 – 1956 and was for some considerable time Press Secretary. He was elected President in 1956 and held this post until 1994. In 1961 Maurice became the first Club Life Member.

Also in 1961 Maurice married Eileen and they had a son Stephen and daughter Susan. By now he had retired from racing, but not from the Club and he worked relentlessly and enthusiastically over many years with Eileen the Club making the club what it is today. Over the last few years health problems took their toll and he was not able to commit himself as he would have wanted, but always kept in touch with myself and never forgot to ask about the Club.

Tuesday 6th November was the last time I spoke to him, and although very poorly, he wanted to know about the Club.



Three days later he passed away, knowing the club he had cherished was sound and successful.

Maurice – you will be missed by the many who knew you.

Our condolences go to Eileen, Susan and Stephen.
